


Low Grade Round Wood & Burnt Feedstock



Canadian Pellet Shipping Routes




Canadian Export Destinations – thousands of tonnes








SBP Implementation

- Dependent on existing long-term contracts


Ontario Domestic Fuel Costs - 2013
